National Security Minister Hon. Robert Montague is describing as fruitful, his recent visit to China.

He recently met with a number of security officials while attending the 86th Interpol General Assembly in Beijing.

The discussions with the security officials centred on China's willingness to assist Jamaica in further strengthening of its national security apparatus.

Among the officials who met with Minister Montague were Beijing's Minister of Public Safety, Guo Shengkun, and INTERPOL's Secretary General, Professor Dr. Jurgen Stock.

China's President Xi Jinping has pledged to help strengthen Interpol, and assist 100 developing countries build or upgrade communication systems and crime labs in the next five years so the law enforcement cooperative can raise its global influence and leadership.

Minister Montague welcomed President Xi's pledge, and looks forward to increased collaboration with the country.

Minister Montague and his delegation also met with a number of representatives from Huawei, including Thomas Xu, President of Public Safety Enterprise; Nadim Abdulrahim, Vice President Public Safety Sector, and Global Public Safety expert.
